ONLINE EXCURSION

HOW TO

- Create two accounts on zoom.us (use two different email accounts)
 - one account on your laptop
 - one account via the zoom app on your mobile phone
- start with your laptop and send the invitation to your second account (app on your phone)
- mute the microphone on your laptop
- (press record on your laptop)
- start the excursion using your mobile phone

good to have ...

- an assistant for the moderation, chat & time
- internet connection, Wi-Fi, data volume
- fully loaded batteries, power bank, selfie stick
- permission of the participants for the recording
- headphones to hear the participants clear



other ideas ...

Invite experts to an online meeting

1. ask students to do some research to the experts topic and to prepare questions to discuss
2. let the expert present his/her topic and let them show their farm
3. finish with a discussion lead by the students who did the research



other ideas ...

Split a full day program into two days

- 1.first day: input for the students
- 2.between the two days: outdoor homework (go to the forest and make some photos of the trees, collect plants ...)
- 3.second day: reflect, share experience, let students present





MOOC

MOOC ?

Massive **O**pen **O**nline **C**ourse



IDEAL FOR

- a large number of interested people (no limit)
- independent of time and location
- from a low-level access to scientifically based information
- graduation with certificate of participation or credits
- many different variants possible (mix online and presence)
- Open Educational Resources (?!)

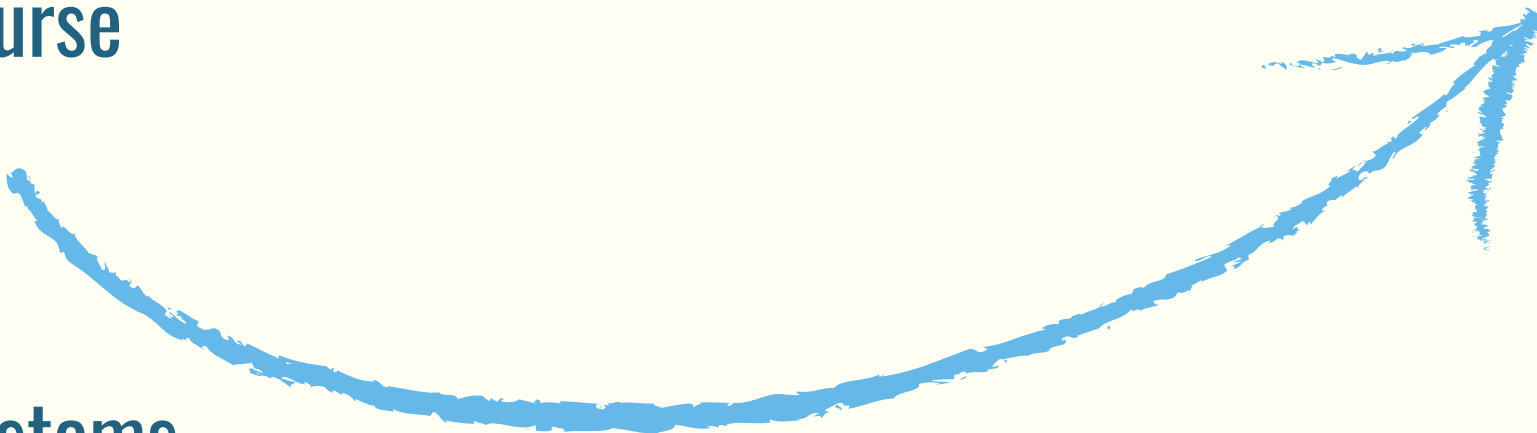

- register to create a pinboard - participants do not have to register
- private or open
- link pictures/videos/web pages/audio
- share and export to Excel/PDF/...
- Use to:
 - [introduce yourself and the participants](#)
 - provide links and documents
 - collect materials, ideas, information
 - ...
- example

LEARNING SNACKS

- simulated conversation between teacher and learners, "digital quiz" - learningsnacks.de
- register to create a learning snack - participants do not have to register
- private or open
- Use to:
 - introduction to a topic
 - small, easily digestible pieces of knowledge
 - ...

Open Educational Resources

... free accessible learning, teaching and training materials with an open license such as Creative Commons!

> Guidelines on the development of open educational resources policies



OER +

- low expenses for students
- extended availability anywhere and anytime
- change course materials
- support different learning types
- fast distribution of information



OER -

- hardware requirements
- quality Control
- restriction of the copyright

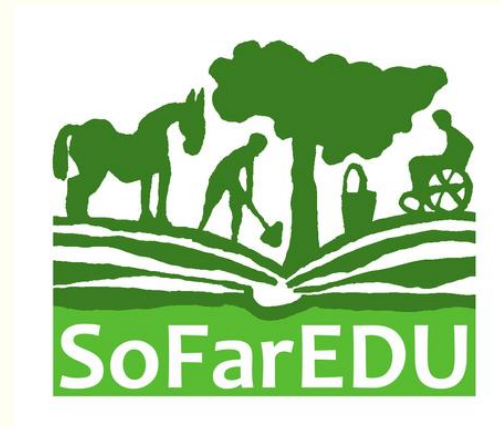
