Topic	Organic Agriculture, Circular Economy

Original language	German and English
Target group	Educators – for teaching in kindergarten, primary and secondary school
Description	<p>This is a circle game for children (kindergarten and primary school) and a story about the different between organic and conventional farming. The game based on a funny story of farmer Bert (also practical for secondary school). He produces on his organic farm food for himself and his animals. On his farm he implements crop rotation and intercropping. Between his fields grow flowers, bushes and trees that attract beneficial animals. The farm changes into a conventional farm and shows the consequences for the environment.</p> <p>The circle game is played on a carpet that shows a farm. At first the children create with photo cards a biological balanced farm. Afterward they follow the story and change the farm as described. The consequences of this changes are well visualized on the carpet.</p> <p>The children have the opportunity to compare both types of management and find out for themselves what they like better. At the end they rebuild organic farm and answer the question "What organic farmers do differently?".</p>
